Minutes of the Senate Committee on Judiciary February 14, 19 78.

Senate Bill 904 - Conservators, investments by. Mr. Don Horttor appeared in support of the bill, and explained its pupose. Following committee discussion, Senator Burke moved to report the bill favorably; Senator Parrish seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Senate Bill 911 - Establishing district attorney in the seventh Judicial district. Senator Berman explained the purpose of the bill. He stated that the Douglas County judges fully support the bill. He stated that a conferee would appear in support of the bill on Thursday.

Senator Gaines moved to approved the minutes of January 31 and February 1; Senator Parrish seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Senate Bill 297 - Natural death act. Senator Simpson discussed the bill, and commented that he didn't agree with all of the suggestions made by Mrs. Mahling. Following extensive committee discussion, the committee, by a vote of four to two, indicated that the committee was willing to spend more time working the bill, at future meetings of the committee.
