



## CONTINUATION SHEET

Minutes of the Senate Committee on Judiciary February 17, 19 78.

Senate Bill 780 - Restoring parental rights after a deprivation or termination thereof pursuant to a divorce or juvenile code action. Following committee discussion, Senator Parrish moved to report the bill favorably; Senator Hein seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Senate Bill 579 - Protection of adults and children from abuse by persons residing with them, tax levy authorization. Senator Parrish discussed a proposed amendment to the bill that would raise tax money for shelters; he also discussed information concerning peace bonds. Following committee discussion, Senator Berman moved to restrict the peace bond to a restraining order; Senator Parrish seconded the motion. Further committee discussion followed, and staff was requested to prepare proposed amendments and bring back to the committee ballooned copies of the bill with the proposed amendments shown thereon.

Senate Bill 825 - Juvenile code revision. Mr. Stephens explained the ballooned copy of the bill. Mr. Griggs also presented background information concerning the bill. Extensive committee discussion followed, including discussion of removing truants and waywards from the juvenile code. Senator Simpson moved that truants be removed from the juvenile code; Senator Hess seconded the motion. Following further committee discussion, the motion was withdrawn. The chairman asked the committee members to study the various issues involved in this bill and proposed amendments thereto over the weekend. He also announced that there would be extra meetings next week to work on bills that the committee had previously heard.

The meeting adjourned.
