House Bill 2707 - Prohibiting law enforcement officers from serving as juvenile probation officers. Jerry Stephens reviewed the bill for the committee. As he discussed the bill section by section, various committee members made comments concerning provisions of the bill.

House Bill 2709 - Crimes, contributing to misconduct or deprivation of a child and aggravated juvenile delinquency. Jerry Stephens reviewed this bill, section by section. Committee discussion followed. Senator Parrish explained how this bill differs from SB 676. Following further committee discussion, Senator Parrish moved to amend the bill by striking lines 68 through 70; Senator Simpson seconded the motion, and the motion carried. Senator Burke moved to amend the bill to provide for a class C misdemeanor; Senator Parrish seconded the motion. Following further committee discussion, Senator Burke withdrew his motion and made a new motion to provide for a class C misdemeanor with the provision that if the judge finds the juvenile guilty, the juvenile must be confined in a segregated facility; Senator Parrish seconded the motion, and the motion carried. Senator Simpson moved to incorporate the provisions of subparagraph 3 of SB 676 into HB 2709; Senator Parrish seconded the motion, and the motion carried. Senator Parrish moved to report the bill favorably as amended; Senator Gaines seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Senate Bill 676 - Prosecutions for aggravated juvenile delinquency to be heard pursuant to juvenile code. Senator Parrish moved that the bill be reported adversely, since the subject had been dealt
