Chairman Hoagland called the meeting to order at 12:30 p.m.

An original motion on Substitute SB 76 (a motion to amend by inserting "J" into the bill, made the previous day in committee) was voted on and the motion to adopt the amendment was passed.

Rep. Stites moved to include "K" "M" and "N" to Substitute SB 76 and to change the word "and" to "or" in "N" and "P." Seconded by Rep. Harper. The amendment was adopted.

Rep. Glover moved to amend "J" by placing a comma instead of a period after the word facilities and add "except when the providing of supervision is reasonably available for the public." Seconded by Rep. Brewster.

A substitute motion was made by Rep. Stites to change "L" by adding "the failure to provide supervision for public facilities for which no fee is charged." Seconded by Rep. Douville. Substitute motion lost with a vote of 7 to 6.

Rep. Douville then moved to add as an exclusion, "the failure to provide police or fire protection." Seconded by Rep. Stites. Motion passed by a vote of 10 to 3.

Moved by Rep. Douville and seconded by Rep. Roth to report Substitute SB 76 favorable as amended. Motion carried.

The meeting was adjourned at 1:40 p.m.
