Mr. Bill Belleville, Acting Director, Division of Information Systems and Computing, conducted the committee on a tour of the DISC facility on the eleventh floor of the State Office Building.

The committee saw the Univac system which serves only the State Department of Administration. It does all of the state payroll system. The group also saw the IBM system which serves all other agencies in the state.

The Honeywell Security System, which is attached to the main State Office Building System, was explained.

The Honeywell Alarm System and smoke detectors were pointed out as well as numerous fire extinguishers in the area.

The tape library was also pointed out - it holds 19,000 reels of tape.

The committee was told that data is stored on tape daily and weekly. Most storage is in other departments. Mr. Belleville indicated the state has duplicates of all information.

The administration section was the last area to be observed.

The tour ended and the committee was adjourned at 4:30 p.m.
