Chairperson Harper called the meeting to order.

At this time, Chairperson Harper introduced Eric Rucker, of the Secretary of State's office. Mr. Rucker appeared on behalf of Senator Hein, author of SB 30, and also for the Secretary of State's office.

H.B. 2999, passed in the 1982 Session of the Legislature, advanced the date of the city and school primary elections by one week. S.B. 30, Mr. Rucker stated, simply does provide technical clean-up to amend various sections to conform with previous legislation relating to the time of certain primary elections.

Rep. Fox moved that S.B. 30 be reported favorable as is. Rep. Acheson seconded. Motion carried.
