MINUTES OF THE House COMMITTEE ON Elections

The meeting was called to order by Representative Richard L. Harper at

Chairperson Harper called the Elections Committee meeting to order. The first order of business on the agenda for this meeting was SB 337, An Act relating to the legislature; concerning the resignation of members thereof. The Chairperson asked Arden Ensley, the Revisor to give background and intent of SB 337. A brief discussion followed here by members of the Committee.

It was moved by Representative Runnels that the Committee pass out SB 337 favorably, and that this bill be placed on Consent Calendar. Motion carried.

SB 338 was next on the agenda. Arden Ensley was asked by Chairperson Harper to give the Committee information as to the background and the purpose of SB 338. After some general discussion, Chairperson Harper called upon Adrian Farver, Kansas Sheriffs Association to appear before the Committee. Mr. Farver testified in favor of SB 338.

Representative Fox moved to recommend SB 338 favorably, and that it be passed out of Committee. Seconded by Representative Acheson. Motion carried.

Representative Justice wished to be recorded as voting no on the above motion.

SB 340 was next on the agenda for discussion. The Revisor explained the bill to the Elections Committee giving informational background. A general discussion was held at this time on SB 340. It was decided that the Senate Bill should be held over until a later date giving some Senate conferees a chance to appear before the Committee.

Representative Blumenthal moved to approve the minutes of the meetings of March 1, 2, 3 and 4th. The motion was seconded by Representative Reinhardt. Motion carried.
