The meeting of the House Governmental Organization Committee was called to order by Vice Chairman Marvin Smith at 9:10 a.m. Discussion was taken up on HB 2502. Rep. Matlack moved to amend HB 2502 by requiring a five year residency for all state licenses and one year for county. Rep. Sughrue gave a second to the motion. The motion carried. Rep. Smith moved to pass out HB 2502 as amended favorably. Rep. Ediger gave a second to the motion. The motion carried.

HB 2505 was taken up by the Committee. Rep. Sughrue moved to pass out HB 2505 favorably. Rep. Hassler gave a second to the motion. The motion carried.

HB 2531 was next under consideration for final action. Avis Swartzman, Revisor passed out a proposed committee report with the amendments the Committee desired to have made on this bill. This consisted of new sentence structure and striking the provisions of subsection (d). Rep. Walker moved to adopt the Committee report. Rep. Murphy gave a second to the motion. The motion carried.

Rep. Walker moved to pass HB 2531 as amended favorably. Rep. Murphy gave a second to the motion. The motion carried.

The Chairman explained that Rep. Erne's bill on licensure and regulation of polygraph and voice analysis examiners will stay in Committee until next year. It is quite an involved bill and will take more input and further work. Rep. Erne concurs with this decision.

The Chairman told the Committee that there will be no meetings next week. March 14 the Committee will meet and take action on the minutes passed out today. The Committee will be hearing Senate Bills. There are still audit reports to be made and reviewed. The Chairman expressed his thanks to the Committee for their participation and adjourned the meeting at 9:33 a.m.
