The meeting of the House Governmental Organization was called to order upon adjournment of the House. The Chairman stated that since no one had notified the secretary of any corrections in the minutes, they would stand approved. The Performance Audit Report on the Department of Revenue, Driver Control Regulatory Program was distributed. A staff paper entitled Entities Subject to the Kansas Sunset Law as of July 1, 1982 was also distributed. The Chairman told the Committee to take the audit home, read the preface, summary and agency response and skim through the rest if they could not find the time to read the entire audit. The Chairman stated that a hearing on SB 41 will take place sometime during the veto session.

Chairman Cloud told the Committee that there will be no more massive audits of agencies. Committee members will have the option of requesting a specific audit of an issue within an agency. Members are requested to have these audit requests in writing, ready to submit to the Chairman when the veto session commences.

Julian Efird, Research Department, stated that audits of the DISC program and the Veterans Commission within the Department of Human Resources are already being started.
