

The addition to the bill can be found in H.B. 2221, the bottom of page 61, section 9.

H.B. 2221 An act concerning the employment security law; relating to benefits and contributions; prescribing certain surcharges on employers; amending K.S.A. 44-703, 44-704, 44-711, 44-714 and 44-717 and K.S.A. 1982 Supp. 44-706 and 44-710a and repealing the existing sections.

The meeting this morning was called because several committee members had questions on the bill.
