Mr. Arnold Berman spoke to the committee on 2511, which was in the Senate yesterday. Two amendments were added to the bill.

The Chairman then called Mr. Paul Bickell to the speakers stand to speak on S.B. 365. A lengthy discussion followed.

The Chairman then asked if any of the committee members had any questions regarding S.B. 140. A motion was made by Representative Hensley to record the bill favorable for passage. The motion was seconded by Representative Sutter. A short discussion followed. Representative Hensley asked to incorporate in his motion that they change Statuete Book to Kansas Register. There was no further discussion. A vote was taken and the motion was carried.

The Chairman then took up S.B. 374. Representative Friedeman made a motion that S.B. 374 be not passed. It was seconded by Representative Sallee. There was no discussion. A vote was taken. The motion was not carried. Representative Sutter made a motion that S.B. 374 be passed favorably. A substitute motion was made by Representative Darrell Webb to pass S.B. 374 with the amendment to include a class "C" misdemeanor for violation of the act. The motion was seconded by Representative Sutter. There was no discussion. A vote was taken and the motion was passed. Representative Sutter made a motion to pass S.B. 374 as amended favorably. The motion was seconded by Representative Darrell Webb. A vote was taken and the motion was passed. Representative Friedeman requested that the minutes show that he voted no.

Chairman Douville called the committee's attention back to S.B. 365. A discussion followed. Representative Moore made a motion to table S.B. 365 until the beginning of next session. The motion was seconded by Representative Nichols. There was no discussion. A vote was taken and the motion was carried. A short discussion followed about the committees future plans.

Chairman Douville adjourned the meeting at 9:40 a.m.
