Chairman Ivan Sand called the meeting to order.

HB 2025 - AN ACT concerning counties; relating to civic centers; amending K.S.A. 19-15,139, 19-15,140 and 19-15,141 and repealing the existing sections.

To open the hearing, Mike Heim, of the staff, gave a brief overview of HB 2025. A copy of his comments are attached (See Attachment I).

Representative Frey, sponsor of HB 2025, was present to give background and intent. He explained that this bill would authorize the building of a civic center in Seward County. He asked that the bill be expedited so to have a referendum in the upcoming April elections. He further asked that the bill be amended in Section 5 to take effect and be in force on publication in the state register.

Representative Dean made the motion, seconded by Representative Acheson, to amend HB 2025 in Section 5 so act will take effect and be in force from and after publication in the state register. Motion carried.

Representative Nichols made the motion, seconded by Representative Douville, to report HB 2025 favorable for passage as amended. Motion carried.

Representative Fry made the motion, seconded by Representative Nichols, to approve the minutes of the January 12, 1983, meeting as printed. Motion carried.

RE: H.B. 2025

H.B. 2025 amends an act authorizing the building of civic centers in Shawnee and Wyandotte counties to include Seward County under its provisions. Seward County is authorized to issue not to exceed \$5 million in general obligation bonds if voters approve. The bonds are not subject to the bonded debt limits of the county.
