Motion by Rep. Walker, and seconded by Rep. Roenbaugh to approve the

Chair strongly urged all members of committee to review the Memorandum's
handed out today from the Legislative Research Department. These con-
tain good background information on HB 2012, and HB 2014, and will be
needed for reference later when discussion takes place in committee on
these bills.

Emalene Correll gave a very comprehensive briefing on HB 2004, and
HB 2005, and HB 2006.

Ms. Correll further gave a rather thorough discussion on the History
of Health Planning, and then a briefing on HB 2012, and HB 2014 followed.

Chair entertained a motion to introduce a separate bill to amend
mill levy section that had been included in HB 2002, Section 27. This
motion was made by Rep. Kenneth King, and seconded by Rep. Elaine
Hassler. Motion carried.

and HB 2006 at tomorrow's meeting, committee will try to take possible
action on those bills.
