Chairman called meeting to order.

Chairman noted that ${\tt HB}\ 2143\ {\tt will}\ {\tt not}\ {\tt be}\ {\tt on}\ {\tt agenda}\ {\tt today},\ {\tt but}\ {\tt will}\ {\tt have}\ {\tt further}\ {\tt hearings}\ {\tt tomorrow}.$

Discussion and action this date on HB 2014, HB 2026, HB 2027, HB 2108, HB 2294, and HB 2337.

HB 2014

Rep. Friedeman moved to amend HB 2014, see (Attachment No. 2.) for details. Explaining his amendment, Rep. Friedeman stated it would establish some new criteria deciding when a new certificate of need is to be granted to an applicant. Motion seconded by Spaniol.

Rep. Walker made a substitute motion to move this bill out of committee passing favorably. Motion seconded by Rep. Harder.

Rep. Spaniol in discussion felt that Rep. Friedeman's amendment should be given consideration, and further discussion took place. <u>Voice vote taken</u> on the substitute motion, and the motion passed. HB 2014 moved out favorably for passage.

HB 2026

Chairman noted to committee to refer to balloon copy of this bill, see Attachment No. 3.). Staff reviewed the balloon, page 1, line 30, a new sentence is being added, "Adult care home does not mean adult family home." Pg. 3, line 82, "after nursing care is provided, "insert, "by the adult care home". Pg.3, line 86, after "or simple nursing care", insert, "provided by the adult care home".

Rep. Green moved to accept amendment on the balloon copy of HB 2026. Seconded by Rep. Wagnon, and motion carried.

Discussion followed on the language regarding 24 hours inclusive care, and respite care. Rep. Kline then made a motion to move HB 2026 out favorably for passage. Motion seconded by Rep. Hassler, and motion carried.

HB 2027

Rep. Blumenthal had a balloon amendment distributed to committee on HB 2027. Pg.2, line 49, insert paragraph as shown in (Attachment No. 4.). Rep. Blumenthal moved this amendment to HB 2027 be adopted, seconded by Rep. Harder. Motion carried. A second amendment was proposed and suggested changes are shown on (Attachment No. 5.) Line 27, pg. 1, insert, "live independently". Line 29, insert, "The home is not required to furnish". Line 30, insert, "Adult family home does not mean adult care home". A motion by Rep. Wagnon was made to accept these amendments on HB 2027, the

Rep. Hassler moved that HB 2027 be reported out of committee as amended. Motion seconded by Rep. Blumenthal.

A substitute motion by Rep. Long that HB 2027 be reported out adversely, seconded by Rep. Spaniol, no discussion. Voice vote taken, then a show of hands indicated 5 yes, and 8 no. Substitute motion dies. HB 2027 reported out of committee as amended.

HB 2108

Rep. Green moved to pass this bill out favorably. Seconded by Rep. Kline, motion carried.

HB 2294

Rep. Wagnon noted that clean up language is necessary on this bill. Pg. 3. Sec. 3. Rep. Wagnon moved to strike Sec. 3 (a) and re-number sub-sections (b) and (c). Rep. Harder seconded the motion. Further discussion. Voice vote taken, and motion carried.

Motion seconded by Rep. Helgerson, and motion carried.

Rep. Friedeman referred back to Rep. King's motion to move HB 2337 out favorably as amended. Seconded by Rep. Hassler, motion carried.

"Sec. 4. K.S.A. 65-4804 is hereby amended to read as follows: 65-4804. (a) A certificate of need may be granted only after an opportunity has been given to the appropriate health systems agency to review the project proposal, in accordance with procedures established in K.S.A. 65-4807, and the state agency has determined that, on the basis of evidence in the record with respect—to—community—need—as—reflected—in—the—state—health—plan er—other—criteria—specified—by—the—statewide—health—coordinating council—until—a—state—health—plan—is—developed—and—approved there is a sufficient need for the proposed project, based on the factors specified in subsection (b).

(b) In deciding whether there is sufficient need for the proposed project, the state agency shall consider the following factors: (1) Whether adequate financing exists with preference for given for projects/which financing is arranged; (2) whether the proposed project duplicates services available within the geographic area to be served; (3) whether the proposed project will be cost-effective in providing the services to be offered; (4) whether the proposed project will improve the efficiency with which the services to be offered will be provided; (5) whether the proposed project will encourage competition within the geographic area to be served; (6) whether the quality of care will be improved within the geographic area to be served if the proposed project is approved; (7) the degree of support for the proposed project within the community to be served; (8) whether the proposed project will maximize the utilization of scarce resources; (9) whether the use of outpatient facilities will be encouraged by approval of the proposed project; (10) whether approval of the proposed project will discourage over-utilization of services; and (11) whether approval of the proposed project will assist in the recruitment of physicians to the community to

Section 1. K.S.A. 1982 Supp. 39-923 is hereby amended to 0022 read as follows: 39-923. (a) The following words and phrases when As used in this act shall, for the purposes of this act, have 0024 the meanings respectively ascribed to them in this section:

- (1) "Adult care home" means any skilled nursing home, one intermediate nursing care home, intermediate personal care home, one-bed adult care home and two-bed adult care home and any boarding care home, all of which classifications of adult care homes are required to be licensed by the secretary of health and environment.
- (2) "Skilled nursing home" means and includes any place or facility operating for not less than 24 hours in any week and caring for three or more individuals not related within the third degree of relationship to the administrator or owner by blood or marriage and who by reason of aging, illness, disease or physical or mental infirmity are unable to sufficiently or properly care for themselves, and for whom reception, accommodation, board and skilled nursing care and treatment is provided, and which place or facility is staffed to provide 24 hours a day licensed nursing personnel plus additional staff, and is maintained and equipped primarily for the accommodation of individuals who are not acutely ill and are not in need of hospital care but who require

care and treatment and skilled nursing care, supervised nursing care or simple nursing care is provided, and which place or simple nursing care is provided, and which place or sacility is staffed, maintained and equipped primarily for the accommodation of individuals not acutely ill or in need of hospital care but who require domiciliary care and skilled nursing care, supervised nursing care or simple nursing care. When the home's capabilities are questioned in writing, the licensing agency shall determine according to its rules and regulations if any restriction will be placed on the care the home will give residents.

- 0091 (6) "Boarding care home" means and includes any place or 0092 facility operating for not less than 24 hours in any week and 0093 caring for three or more individuals not related within the third 0094 degree of relationship to the administrator or owner by blood or 0095 marriage and who by reason of aging, illness, disease or physical 0096 or mental infirmity are unable to sufficiently or properly care for 0097 themselves and for whom reception, accommodation, board and 0098 supervision is provided and which place or facility is staffed, 0099 maintained and equipped primarily to provide shelter to resion dents who require some supervision, but who are ambulatory 0101 and essentially capable of managing their own care and affairs.

- (a) (1) The home shall meet health standards and safety reg-0054 ulations of the community and the provisions of chapter 20 of the 0055 national fire protection association, life safety code, pamphlet no. 0056 101, 1981 edition.
- 0057 (2) The home shall have a written plan to get persons out of 0058 the home rapidly in case of fire, tornado or other emergency.
- 0059 (3) No more than two clients shall be in residence at any one 0060 time.
- 0061 (4) The home shall have adequate living and sleeping space 0062 for clients.
- 0063 (5) Each room shall have an operable outside window.
- 0064 (6) Electric fans shall be made available to reduce the tem-0065 perature if there is no air conditioning. Rooms shall be heated, 0066 lighted, ventilated and available.
- 0067 (7) Sleeping rooms shall have space for personal items.
- 0068 (8) Each client shall have a bed which is clean and in good 0069 condition.
- 0070 (9) Lavatory and toilet facilities shall be accessible, available 0071 and in working order.
- 0072 (10) The kitchen shall be clean with appliances in good 0073 working order.
- 0074 (b) (1) A healthy and safe environment shall be maintained 0075 for clients.



AMENDMENT TO H.B. 2027 REQUIRING ANNUAL RENEWAL OF REGISTRATION AND ONE UNANNOUNCED INSPECTION



Line 0148. Section 5. Add new sections "c" and "d" to read:

(c) Registration, unless sooner suspended or revoked, shall be renewable annually upon filing of the registrant and approved by the secretary and the state fire marshall or their duly authorized agents, of an annual application for renewal upon such information in such form as the secretary prescribes. If application for renewal is not so filed, such registration is automatically chacelled as of the date of expiration.

Authorized agents and representatives of the agency shall conduct at least one unannounced inspection of each adult family home during each year for the purpose of determing whether the adult family home is complying with the provisions of this act and applicable rules and regulations relating to the health and safety of the clients of the adult family home.
