The first meeting was called to order by Chairman Rex Crowell and introductions were made. Procedural policies were reviewed with the Chairman requesting that Members receive recognition from the Chair before questioning and discussion; that tabling will require a simple majority; that a simple majority will be required to take a bill off the table; that a simple majority will be required to table a bill to a time certain; that a two-thirds majority will be required to take a bill off the table before the time certain.

Agendas for the following week were distributed and Chairman Crowell noted that there would not be any meetings Thursday or Friday of this week (January 13th and 14th).

Representative Shelor inquired as to procedure for committee bills. Chairman Crowell responded by stating that introduction of committee bills would depend on the wishes of the committee in each specific instance.

Chairman Crowell stated that regular meeting days would be Monday through Thursday, unless otherwise announced, from 1:30 p.m. to approximately 3:00 p.m.; that it would be necessary for the meeting to be adjourned by 3:30 p.m.; that he (Chairman Crowell) was hopeful Friday meetings would not be necessary.
