MINUTES OF THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON EDUCATION

HB 2175 - School district finance; budget limitations, 1983-84 school year.

After a call to order by Committee Chairman Joseph C. Harder, the Chairman asked for Committee discussion and/or consideration of HB 2175.

Senator Allen moved to amend HB 2175 by deleting Subsection (e) under Section 2 relating to an additional .75 of one percent budget authority to be used exclusively for teachers' salaries. After a second by Senator Montgomery, the motion carried. Nay votes are recorded for Senators Parrish and Rehorn.

Senator Angell then moved to change the budget authority limitations to 2½% and 5%, and this motion was seconded by Senator Kerr, who explained that his support for HB 2175 was based on the poor economic conditions which presently exist.

Senator Parrish offered a substitute motion to change the budget authority limitations to 4% and 8%, and this was seconded by Senator Rehorn. When the Chairman asked for a vote on the substitute motion, he ruled that it did not carry. Aye votes are recorded for Senators Parrish, Rehorn, and Winter.

When the Chairman called for a vote on the primary motion to amend the bill with 2½% and 5% budget authority limitations, the Chairman ruled that the motion had carried. Nay votes are recorded for Senators Parrish, Rehorn, and Winter.

Senator Allen then moved to report HB 2175, as amended, favorably for passage. After a second by Senator Angell, the motion carried. Nay votes are recorded for Senators Parrish, Rehorn, and Winter.

The Chairman adjourned the meeting.
