The minutes of the February 1, 1983 meeting were approved.

S.B. 61 - Amending and supplementing the state water plan storage act.

The Committee resumed discussion of the provisions of Section 5 of the bill.

Senator Gannon moved that lines 202 and 203 read as follows: "(3) provisions that the authority may review and adjust the rate provided in paragraph (1) on July 15 of each year effective January 1 of the". Senator Kerr seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Senator Kerr moved that line 165 read as follows: "waters is for any purpose other than for streamflow maintenance or reservoir pool management,". Senator Werts seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Senator Gannon moved that the word "30th" be inserted in place of "60th" in line 268. Senator Chaney seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Senator Werts moved that the phrase, "and as provided in any statute regulating interbasin water transfers," be stricken from lines 299 and 300. Senator Kerr seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Senator Feleciano made a conceptual motion that the costs mentioned in Section 7 (4) be based on actual costs of the preceding year. Senator Werts seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Senator Kerr made a conceptual motion that a new subsection 10 be added after line 391 to provide that minimum streamflow would be one of the considerations for deciding whether to approve contracts. Senator Gannon seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:59 a.m. by the Chairman.
