Conferees appearing before the committee:

HB2505 - relating to alcoholic beverages, license fees.

The Chairman asked Russell Mills to distribute figures prepared by the staff concerning Comparison of Liquor Licensee Fee, Increases in SB327 and HB2505. (It was SB327 as amended by Senate committee and HB2505 as passed by the House.) It is a part of the Minutes as Attachment #1. The committee discussed the hand-out.

Senator Roitz moved to blend SB327 as amended into HB2505. 2d by Senator Morris. Motion carried.

Senator Francisco moved to amend HB2505 to change \$500 concerning class "A" clubs to \$300. 2d by Senator Gannon.

Senator Roitz made a substitution motion to recommend HB2505 favorably for passage as amended. 2d by Senator Morris. Motion carried.

Sub. for HB2551 - relating to licensure and regulation of manufacture and sales of wine by farm wineries.

The Chairman called the committee's attention to Sub. for HB2551, but no action was taken on the bill.

The meeting adjourned at 1:35 p.m.
