A special meeting of the Senate Governmental Organization Committee was called for the purpose of taking final action on several bills.

The Chairman instructed the committee to look at Senate Bill 40. Senator Johnston made the motion to pass Senate Bill 40 favorably out of committee with the recommendation that the Chairman write a letter to the Chairman of the Legislative Post Audit Department and request that they take another look at the accounting system in the DOT for fiscal 1984. This was seconded by Senator Roitz. Motion carried.

Senator Hein then made a motion to recommend Senate Bill 132 favorable for passage, Senator Mulich seconded this. Motion carried.

Discussion was then turned to Senate Bill 160. Senator Johnston made a motion to add an amendment to limit to construction those that are required to be bid by the statutes. Senator Mulich made the seconded. Motion carried to adopt the amendment. Senator Johnston then made a motion to report Senate Bill 160 favorable for passage. Senator Mulich seconded. Motion carried.

On Senate Bill 46 a motion was made by Senator Hein to amend the balloon version submitted by the sub-committee to include the Sheriffs and District Attorneys. This was seconded by Senator Johnston. Motion carried. A motion was then made by Senator Hein to recommend Senate Bill 46 favorable for passage. Senator Johnston seconded this. Motion carried. (Exhibit A)
