Senator Hein made a motion to add to Sec. 11, page 15, after the words records in line 540, the words "other than from public records of the division of vehicles under 74-2012)." This was seconded by Senator Roitz and after some discussion on this matter the motion carried.

It was the consensus of the committee to make Sec. 16, page 16 a part of Sec. 2 on page 1.

At this point Senator Francisco made the motion to pass House Bill ²³²⁷ ~~2370~~ favorably out of committee. Senator Mulich seconded this and motion carried.
