MINUTES OF THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON JUDICIARY

Senator Hein moved to approve the minutes of January 11, 1983; Senator Feleciano seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Senator Werts presented a request for the introduction of a committee bill that would amend the automobile injury reparations act concerning the threshold for filing damages actions. Following his explanation of the proposal, Senator Werts moved that the bill be introduced and referred to the appropriate committee; Senator Gaar seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

The chairman introduced Phil Root, legislative intern, to committee members.

Staff then reviewed Proposals #14, #15, #16, #34 and #38.

The chairman referred to the agenda for next week and announced there should be time each day for consideration of presentation of proposals to the committee for introduction of committee bills. The chairman announced the committee will have hearings on Senate Bill 34, January 17; Senate Bill 14, January 18; Senate Bill 7 (proponents), January 19; Senate Bill 7 (opponents), January 20; and Senate Bill 25 on January 21. The chairman also announced Senate Bill 28, the good samaritan food law, is scheduled for a hearing on January 26.

Senator Gaines presented a request for the introduction of a committee bill that would make it a felony to possess firearms in the clubs. Following his explanation, Senator Gaines moved that the bill be introduced as a committee bill and referred back to the committee; Senator Mulich seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

The chairman announced there is no committee meeting scheduled tomorrow, and reminded the committee the Senate meets at 12:00 noon today.

The meeting adjourned.
