MINUTES OF THE Senate COMMITTEE ON Local Government

Senator Gaar asked the Committee to address two areas of immediate importance, as follows:

1) The United States Congress passed legislation requiring that the principal and interest on tax exempt securities of state and local governments be in registered form. Responding to 26 states which would be unable under state laws to issue bonds in compliance with the new federal laws, the Congress authorized a six-month moratorium; therefore, the staff was directed to draft legislation to authorize those acts required under federal law.

2) As a result of problems experienced statewide and particularly in Shawnee, Sedgwick, Johnson and Finney Counties, statutory revisions have been drafted to bring about more extensive due process by notice and, in general, more understanding between governing bodies, developers and the property owners who will be assessed for sewer improvements. Senator Ehrlich moved the introduction by the committee of such legislation. Senator Roitz seconded the motion, and it carried by unanimous vote.

Senator Gaar adjourned the meeting.
