MINUTES OF THE Senate COMMITTEE ON Local Government

The meeting was called to order by Senator Gaar at

Senator Gaar opened the hearing on S.B. 49, which would authorize the advancement of expenses for a sheriff to travel to another state for the purpose of transporting a prisoner pursuant to a Governor's extradition requisition. Senator Daniels moved, conceptually, to amend the bill by changing certain language which might be interpreted to provide that a sheriff could be compensated twice for expenses incurred. Senator Parrish seconded the motion and it carried by unanimous vote. Senator Montgomery moved the bill be reported favorably as amended. Senator Winter seconded the motion and it carried by unanimous vote. Senator Gaar appointed Senator Francisco to carry the bill.

Senator Gaar recommended committee introduction of a bill to amend the Kansas Single Family Mortgage Revenue Act to bring it to conformity with, and provide maximum flexibility under, the new federal laws. Senator Gaines moved introduction of the bill. Senator Daniels seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Senator Gaar then requested committee introduction of a bill to amend the law authorizing cities and counties to refund existing bond issues for the purpose of saving net interest costs over the life of the bonds. Senator Gaines moved to introduce the bill. The motion was seconded by Senator Daniels and was carried by unanimous vote.

Senator Gaar advised the committee that he will introduce a bill, at the request of the Register of Deeds Association, to change the fee for release of tax liens.

Senator Daniels moved to approve the minutes of the January 20, 1983 meeting as distributed. Senator Parrish seconded the motion and it carried.

The meeting was adjourned to January 26, 1983.
