The committee acted on the following bills which had been previously considered:

S.B. 193, authorizing a city to exercise its powers when legislation challenging its incorporation is pending - Senator Daniels moved to report the bill favorably for passage. Senator Ehrlich seconded the motion and it carried by unanimous vote. Senator Daniels was appointed to carry the bill.

S.B. 194, authorizing a city to issue general obligation bonds when litigation pertaining to its incorporation is pending. Senator Daniels moved to report the bill favorably for passage. Senator Ehrlich seconded the motion and it carried by unanimous vote. Senator Daniels was appointed to carry the bill.

S.B. 197, providing that when litigation is brought against an incorporated city challenging its incorporation all resolutions directed toward annexing such city will be invalid until the final court decision is rendered. Following discussion, Senator Bogina moved and Senator Mulich seconded to amend the bill by striking "60" in line 0037 and inserting "35" in lieu thereof. The motion carried, with Senator Daniels voting no. Senator Daniels moved to report the bill as amended favorably for passage. Senator Mulich seconded the motion and it carried by unanimous vote. Senator Daniels was appointed to carry the bill.

Senator Gaar asked the committee to direct its attention to  $\underline{\text{S.B. }155}$ , concerning creation of sewer districts and powers of governing bodies, and suggested several nonsubstantive changes to consolidate certain sections to put the provisions of the bill in more logical sequence. Senator Gaar indicated that he would incorporate these and other nonsubstantive changes in a new bill draft for consideration by the committee.

Senator Daniels moved to approve the minutes of the March 1, 1983 meeting as distributed. Senator Bogina seconded the motion, and it carried.

Senator Gaar adjourned the meeting to 12:00 Noon, March 2, 1983.
