

MINUTES OF THE Senate COMMITTEE ON Local Government

The meeting was called to order by Senator Gaar at

All members were present except: Senator Gaines, who was excused.

Senator Gaar distributed a substitute bill for S.B. 155, concerning sewer districts in counties, incorporating substantive and nonsubstantive decisions previously discussed by the committee. At the suggestion of Senator Parrish, the committee agreed the bill needed further amending to clearly state that costs of a preliminary survey will be assessed against the petitioners in the event the determination is not to proceed with the project. Senator Allen moved adoption of the amendments. Senator Daniels seconded the motion, and the motion carried by unanimous vote. Senator Ehrlich moved to report the amended bill favorably for passage. Senator Mulich seconded the motion, and it carried by unanimous vote.

Senator Gaar asked the committee to review the balloon of S.B. 9, relating to drainage districts, containing amendments proposed by Jack Euler and Art Griggs and previously distributed to the committee. Senator Ehrlich moved adoption of the proposed amendments. Senator Bogina seconded the motion, and it carried by unanimous vote. Senator Mulich moved and Senator Bogina seconded to report the bill as amended favorably for passage. The motion carried. Senator Allen was assigned to carry the bill.

Mr. Alderson, Deputy Attorney General, appeared before the committee to ask consideration of amendments to S.B. 303, authorizing inter-local contracts for law enforcement services, such amendments having been drafted with the assistance of the League of Municipalities. Senator Parrish moved to so amend the bill. Senator Bogina seconded the motion, and it carried by unanimous vote. Senator Bogina moved to report the bill as amended favorably for passage. Senator Mulich seconded the motion and it carried by unanimous vote. Senator Parrish was assigned to carry the bill.

Senator Gaar and Ms. Kiernan reviewed the substitute bill for S.B. 265, concerning registration of bonds, which contained amendments previously discussed and adopted by the committee. Senator Mulich moved and Senator Bogina seconded adoption of all amendments, and the motion carried unanimously. Senator Daniels moved to report the bill as amended favorably for passage. Senator Bogina seconded the motion, and it carried by unanimous vote.

Senator Allen moved to amend S.B. 302 in the manner provided in Attachment I hereto. Senator Daniels seconded the motion, and it carried by unanimous vote. Senator Montgomery moved to report the bill favorably for passage as amended. Senator Bogina seconded the motion and it carried unanimously. Senator Montgomery was assigned to carry the bill.

Senator Winter moved to amend S.B. 286, relating to special benefit districts for construction of improvements, by substituting language which would amend K.S.A. 12-6a01 to make that statute clear that property reasonably benefited by an improvement can be assessed. Senator Mulich seconded the motion and it carried unanimously. Senator Bogina moved to report the bill as amended favorably for passage. Senator Mulich seconded the motion and it carried by unanimous vote. Senator Winter was appointed to carry the bill.

Senator Daniels moved to report S.B. 253, relating to reimbursement of mileage expenses to county commissioners, favorably for passage. Senator Parrish seconded the motion, and it carried. Senator Gaar requested that Senator Francisco be asked to carry the bill.

Senator Montgomery moved to approve the minutes of the March 7, 1983 meeting. Senator Mulich seconded the motion and it carried.

On p. 2, in line 71, by striking "and operation"; in line 72, by striking "and" and inserting "or"; also in line 72, following the period, by inserting "Counties in which there is located any territory of a hospital district operating under the provisions of Chapter 80 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated may not establish a county hospital or health-related facility under this section or pursuant to the provisions of 1983 HB-2002, and amendments thereto."
