MINUTES OF THE Senate COMMITTEE ON Local Government

Senator Gaar opened the hearings. Representative Matlack explained and spoke in support of H.B. 2334, concerning the correction of plats, and H.B. 2335, concerning vacation of plats. Following committee discussion, Senator Gaar asked Representative Matlack, Senator Bogina and Chris McKenzie of the League of Municipalities to meet to correct certain language problems in the bill.

Ms. VanBuren spoke in support of H.B. 2344, which specifies that expenses and compensation of district coroners will not be charged to the operating budget of the district courts.

Mr. Farver addressed the committee in support of H.B. 2374, providing for the advancement of expenses for performance of official duties of sheriffs and their deputies.

Senator Mulich moved to amend H.B. 2404, regarding expense reimbursement of Wyandotte County park commissioners, to provide that the park commissioners will be reimbursed for expenses verified by voucher in an amount not to exceed \$200 per month. Senator Daniels seconded the motion, and it carried by unanimous vote. Senator Mulich moved and Senator Ehrlich seconded to report the bill favorably for passage as amended. The motion carried.

Senator Daniels moved to approve the minutes of the March 16, 1983 meeting. Senator Mulich seconded the motion, and it carried.
