Senator Gaar opened the hearing on H.B. 2552, which concerns the authority of the governing body of the city to acquire and sell certain property. Scott Wright of Wichita introduced Wayne Isaac, who is the Federal Aid Coordinator for the City of Wichita. Mr. Isaac testified that the bill was requested to enable cities to sell surplus land which is no longer needed for a public purpose.
