SB 11 - concerning act for obtaining a guardian or conservator, or both

Norman Furse, Revisor of Statutes Office, reviewed SB 11, and noted major changes recommended by the Interim Committee. The changes include the addition of standard of proof; the requirement that guardians make an annual report to the court; requirement of a periodic review by the court; stating powers and duties of a guardian; allowing limited guardianship and stating limitations thereon; addition of statutes authorizing appointment of non-profit corporations as guardians; authorization of a standby guardian; limitation of number of wards or conservatees assigned to a guardian or conservator; clarification of definition of the terms guardian, conservator, incapacitated, disabled, conservatee, ward, etc.

Mr. Furse reviewed each section of SB 11, noting the major changes relating to each section, along with several technical changes.

Senator Meyers announced that the meeting the next day would be shorter than usual, and that the committee will hear first from the judicial council, and then from out-of-town conferees.

Senator Francisco moved that the minutes of January 27 and January 28, 1983, be approved. Senator Hayden seconded the motion and it carried.

The meeting was adjourned.
