SB 10 - limiting number of persons authorized to operate certain adult care homes

Senator Meyers asked for discussion and action on SB 10. Dr. Joseph Hollowell, Director, DH&E, commented briefly on the benefits of the bill.

Senator Morris moved that SB 10 be reported favorably. Senator Bogina seconded the motion and it carried.

SB 26 - administration of medications by unlicensed persons

Senator Meyers asked for discussion and action on SB 26.

Norman Furse, Revisor of Statutes Office, distributed copies of proposed amendments to SB 26. (Attachment #1).

Senator Johnston moved that the amendments be adopted. Senator Morris seconded the motion, and it carried.

There was discussion concerning the amendment proposed by Keith Landis, Christian Science Committee on Publication for Kansas. Dr. Lois Scibetta, Kansas State Board of Nursing, objected to the term "nursing" and said that the term "non-medical nursing" would be more confusing.

Senator Hayden moved that SB 26, as amended, be reported favorably. Senator Johnston seconded the motion and it carried.

SB 31 - Secretary of SRS authorized to establish substance abuse treatment programs

Senator Meyers asked for discussion and action on SB 31.

Senator Francisco made a conceptual motion that the alcohol and drug abuse use can be treated in the same program, and not two separate programs. Senator Johnston seconded the motion and it carried.

"(j) the practice of mental health technology by licensed mental health technicians as authorized under the mental health technician's licensure act.";

Recommends that Senate Bill No. 31

"AN ACT authorizing the secretary of social and rehabilitation services to establish and administer programs for the treatment or care of substance abusers as therein defined."

Be amended:

On page 1, in line 25, by striking "any" and inserting in lieu thereof: "(1) Any"; by striking all of lines 27 and 28 and inserting in lieu thereof: "in K.S.A. 65-4003 and amendments thereto; or (2) any drug abuser as such term is defined in K.S.A. 65-4002 and amendments thereto; or (3) any combination of (1) and (2).";

And the bill be passed as amended.
