
MINUTES OF THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON TRANSPORTATION AND UTILITIES

The meeting was called to order by Senator Talkington, Chairman, who asked Senator Bill Morris as subcommittee chairman involving Senate Bill 307 to review the outcome of amendments necessary for the bill.

SENATE BILL 307 - ACTION

Senator Morris indicated that the result of phasing out current blue license plates and increasing fees of personalized plates to \$40 would save the State 2½ million dollars. There would be two personalized plates issued to each vehicle instead of the one plate currently issued. The \$40 increase would take place within the next license renewal cycle in 1985 costing \$8 a year for five years.

Senator Morris moved to amend Senate Bill 307 by increasing fees to \$40 for personalized license plates and issuing two plates for each vehicle; seconded by Senator Kerr. The motion carried.

Senator Morris moved that Senate Bill 307 be reported favorable for passage as amended; seconded by Senator Kerr and passed.
