The meeting was called to order by Chairman Bill Fuller. He informed the committee there might be a change in the agenda the next day. He explained the Senate Agriculture committee is holding hearings on SB 519 and expect conferees from out of state and England. Rather than ask them to return, out or courtesy, the Chairman would let them tell their story while they are here.

The committee discussed HB 2299, the inspection and calibration of moisture testing devices.

Staff briefly reviewed the bill. The bill was originally heard in committee last year, taken from the table this session with Rep. Harper, the sponsor offering an amendment.

Rep. Johnson moved to amend Section 7, Line 86 for the bill to take effect 1-1-85. The motion was seconded by Rep. Shelor and motion carried.

Rep. Apt offered an amendment as a compromise. See attachment. Staff explained that everything in brackets was deleted.

After much discussion, Rep. Teagarden made a substitute motion to table HB 2299 and the pending amendments. Rep. Arbuthnot seconded the motion and motion carried.

Rep. Teagarden reported he is dropping the request at this time regarding auctioneer licensing.

Chairman Fuller adjourned the meeting at 9:30 a.m.
