The meeting was called to order by the Chairman, who called for discussion on ambient air quality control.

There was concern expressed that grain elevators may be paying too much of the fees. The time frame of the inspections was also discussed.

Discussion was opened on HB 2839, concerning mining and quarrying. Concern was expressed about interpretation of the excavation formula, and whether this bill would interfere with present statutes. The Chairman appointed the following subcommittee to look at the various concerns and make a report on Friday: Chairman, Rep. Campbell, and members, Representatives Eckert and Bussman.

After discussion on HB 2891, concerning rabies vaccine, Rep. Solbach offered a conceptual motion to amend the bill by having staff prepare a balloon. The motion was seconded by Rep. Arbuthnot, and upon vote carried.
