

MINUTES OF THE HOUSE COMMITTEE ON ASSESSMENT AND TAXATION.

The meeting was called to order by Representative Jim Braden at

Conferees appearing before the committee:

Discussion was held on House Bill 2822 which would enact a new section to grant a sales tax refund for tax paid on equipment purchased for the purpose of treating hazardous waste.

Representative Rolfs made a motion to conceptually amend House Bill 2822 to remove the sunset dates from the bill. Representative Aylward seconded the motion. The motion failed.

Representative Rolfs made a motion that House Bill 2822 be reported favorable for passage and Representative Lowther seconded the motion.

Representative Ott made a substitute conceptual motion to change the sunset date so that it would sunset two years after a generator of hazardous waste comes under regulation of the Secretary of Health and Environment. Representative Erne seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Representative Rolfs made a motion that House Bill 2822 be reported favorable for passage as amended and Representative Roe seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Discussion was then held on House Bill 2823 which enacts a new section to grant an income tax credit of up to \$200 for costs incurred by the taxpayer in treating its hazardous waste.

Representative Ott made a conceptual motion to change the sunset date on House Bill 2823 so that it would sunset two years after a generator of hazardous waste comes under the regulation of the Secretary of Health and Environment. Representative Erne seconded the motion.

Representative Leach made a substitute motion that House Bill 2823 be reported favorable for passage and Representative Wagnon seconded the motion. The motion carried.

The committee then discussed HCR 5009 which would amend the Kansas Constitution to classify property in Kansas.

Representative Rolfs made a motion that House Concurrent Resolution 5009 be reported favorable for passage as amended and Representative Frey seconded the motion.

Representative Crowell made a substitute conceptual motion that the stricken language in lines 49-53 on page two of HCR 5009 be reinserted and 1989 changed to 1990. Representative Erne seconded the motion. The motion carried.
