The meeting was called to order by Chairman Mike Meacham. Copies of the Committee's Summary of Data Processing Recommendations to the 1984 Legislature, Prepared by the Kansas Legislative Research Department, were distributed. The Chairman noted that this contained results of part of the Committee's work during the summer and would be released to the Ways and Means Committee and some others.

Chairman Meacham welcomed Representative Helgerson, a new member of the Committee, replacing Representative Branson. He announced that Representative Baker is now a permanent member of the Committee. He introduced Mr. Jim Wilson, who is now the committee staff member from the Revisor's Office.

Sherry Brown of the Research Department distributed copies of Volume I, Comprehensive Plan for Data Processing In Kansas Government, First Annual Update, prepared by the Division of Information Systems and Computing, Department of Administration, August 1983, along with their Comprehensive Plan For Data Processing in Kansas Government, FY 1985-87 (In Brief), dated November 1, 1983.

The Chairman advised the Committee that the next two weeks would be spent primarily on data processing recommendations so they can be sent to the Ways and Means Committee. Telephone divestiture will probably be taken up in February. Public television will be considered in late January and February. One meeting next week will be devoted to the KBI. The water issue will be taken up later.
