House Bills 2589, 2593, 2594, 2595, 2596 and 2597, a group of bills concerning telephone public utilities, which were pre-filed by Representative Heinemann.

House Bill 2615 by this Committee Re Proposal No. 9, relating to computer services for certain state agencies.

House Bill 2652 by Representatives Hayden, Hoagland, Foster and Chronister regarding establishment by the Department of Economic Development of incubator facilities to provide building space and support services for small business concerns.

House Bills 2670 and 2673 by Representative Fox concerning the Kansas applied remote sensing program.
