MINUTES OF THE House COMMITTEE ON Elections

Chairperson Harper called the House Elections Committee to order, and passed the meeting over to Representative Fox, author of HB 2700, An Act concerning water districts; relating to elections therein; amending K.S.A. 19-3507a and repealing the existing section. Representative Fox at this time turned the floor over to Bill Anderson, Water District # 1, Johnson County.

After a brief explanation of HB 2700 by Mr. Anderson and a short discussion, it was moved by Representative Blumenthal that HB 2700 be reported out of Committee favorably, and be placed on consent calendar. Seconded by Representative Fox. Motion carried.

Next on the agenda was Carol Williams, of the Public Disclosure Commission. Copies of the Annual Report and Recommendations of the Commission had been passed out to the Committee members. (Attachment 1) At this time, Ms. Williams explained the recommendations which had been made to the Governor and the Legislature.

After a short question and answer period, the floor was then turned over to Janet Williams of the Public Disclosure Commission. At this time, Janet explained to the Committee, the state conflict of interests statutes. (Pages 16, 17 and 18 of Attachment 1)

Chairperson Harper thanked the Public Disclosure Commission for coming before the Committee.

A motion was made by Representative Kline to approve the minutes of the January 19, 1984, meeting of the Election Committee. Seconded by Representative Justice. Motion carried.

The meeting adjourned at 9:47 a.m.
