The meeting was called to order by Chairman Miller.

Due to a conflict, Secretary Barbar will be unable to testify at the hearing on Tuesday, so the corrections bills will be heard on Wednesday, January 18 along with HB2599. There will be no meeting on Tuesday and HB2665, 2666, and HB2621 will be heard on Thursday, January 19. A revised agenda was distributed.

Representative Ramirez made a motion, seconded by Representative Eckert, that the minutes of the January 12 meeting be approved. The motion carried.

HB2664 - Legislative Post Audit Act

Representative Vancrum made a motion, seconded by Representative Aylward, the HB2664 be reported favorably. The motion carried.

Representative Vancrum explained to the committee that there were a number of bills that either have become surplus, the sponsor has decided they are no longer needed or it appeared in discussion with the sponsor that he was going to replace the bill with other legislation. Representative Vancrum made a motion, seconded by Representative Matlack, that HB2066, HB2138, HB2147, HB2160, HB2521 and HB2607 be reported adversely. The motion carried.
