SB856 - Securities commission - special investigators

Larry Christ, Kansas Securities Commission, explained the bill and why it was introduced.

Representative Smith made a conceptual motion to remove all references to carrying firearms. The motion was seconded by Representative Vancrum. The motion carried.

Representative Vancrum made a motion, seconded by Representative Smith, to report SB856 favorably as amended. The motion carried.
