SB 854 - meetings of the state military board

General Tice, Adjutant General, stated that as it is now in the statutes, the board is to meet each quarter. At times, this is unnecessary. It would save the state money if the board could meet only when it is necessary. He explained the board makeup and said its jurisdiction is strickly militia. It is the formal advisor to the governor and legislature.

The Chairman asked if there was anyone else present to speak to the bill. As there was not, he declared this terminated the hearing on SB 854.

Rep. Sprague moved SB 854 be passed. Rep. Murphy gave a second to the motion.
