Chairman Hoy introduced Rep. Bill Buntен, Chairman of the Ways and Means Committee and the Interim Committee that drafted HB 2635. Rep. Buntен briefly described the Interim Committee's study of the Firemen's Relief Act which was passed in 1895, and briefly explained HB 2635. There were questions from the committee, which were answered by Rep. Buntен.

Wayne Morris, of Legislative Research, then went through HB 2635 and explained it, section by section. There were questions of Mr. Morris also, and some committee discussion.

HB 2614 was then explained by Wayne Morris. This bill was also introduced as a result of an Interim Committee study, and is on the same subject as Sub. 2111, which was studied by the committee last year. This bill concerns furnishing proof of motor vehicle liability insurance.

Chairman Hoy announced meetings on Monday and Wednesday of the week of January 23rd to discuss three bills that were introduced last year and held over in the committee, and hearings on HB 2614.
