Chairman Douville asked someone from the committee to explain the use of the set-off procedure on page 3 of H.B. 2746. Representative Donna Whiteman explained this to the committee. If benefits are due and payable to an employee and at the same time they owe a dept to the state under Social Rehabilitation Services or some other type of claim it would be set-off against the amount of compensation payable. Steve Goodman reported that DHR has been withholding support obligations from unemployment compensation since fiscal year 1983 because of a federal requirement.

The committee decided that they would hold H.B. 2746 in abeyance until they received more information on this bill.
