The meeting was called to order by the Chairman. He then called on Mr. Crowther to testify on HB 2924. Mr. Crowther explained that this bill affects those employees of the Legislature who are less than full-time and presently have no retirement program. In answering questions from committee members, he explained that there is no provision for payroll deduction. There is no employee contribution involved; this money comes from the Legislative budget and is administered by Legislative Services. This concluded the hearing on HB 2924.
