Chairman Bunten called the meeting to order at 8:05 a.m.

SUBSTITUTE for HB 3080 -- an act concerning the acquisition and broadcast of instructional and educational television courses for use by postsecondary educational institutions; disallowing out-district tuition for such courses; requiring certain reports; amending K.S.A. 1983 Supp. 13-13a26, 13-13a28, 71-301 and 71-607 and repealing the existing sections.

Representative Meacham explained the bill. Written testimony from Russell F. Adkins, Chairperson, KAPSET was passed out which asks the committee to support the legislation (Attachment 2). A proposed amendment to Substitute bill for HB 3080 was presented for consideration (Attachment 3), but it was not adopted.

Representative Meacham moved that Substitute for HB 3080 be reported favorably for passage, as amended by the first committee. Seconded by Representative Luzzati. Motion carried.

SUBSTITUTE for HB 3081 -- an act relating to centers of excellence at institutions of higher education under the supervision and management of the state board of regents; making and concerning appropriations for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1985, for Kansas state university, Wichita state university and the university of Kansas; providing certain exemptions, authorizing certain transfers, imposing certain restrictions and limitations, and directing or authorizing certain receipts and disbursements and acts incidental to the foregoing.

Representative Chronister explained the bill and moved that Substitute for HB 3081 be reported favorably for passage. Seconded by Representative Meacham. Motion carried.

It is my understanding that House Bill 3080, which concerns the acquisition and broadcast of educational television courses on public television stations, has been favorably recommended to the House Ways and Means Committee by the Committee on Communication, Computers and Technology. This legislation would make it possible for Kansas colleges and universities to offer educational courses for credit utilizing the public TV stations serving our state. Courses broadcast in this manner would reach many Kansas residents who may now find it difficult to continue their education because of commuting distance and personal scheduling problems. The 21 members of the Kansas Association for Post Secondary Educational Television support this effort and have worked closely with the Communication, Computers and Technology Committee in developing this legislation. The KAPSET member institutions, see attached, are convinced that this legislation will make possible much improved access to higher education while making appropriate use of public television stations as educational delivery systems. PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO SUBSTITUTE FOR H.B. NO. 3080

"AN ACT concerning the acquisition and broadcast of instructional and educational television courses for use by postsecondary educational institutions; disallowing out-district tuition for such courses; requiring certain reports; amending K.S.A. 1983 Supp. 13-13a26, 13-13a28, 71-301 and 71-607 and repealing the existing sections."

Be amended:

On page 1, in line 37, preceding the period by inserting ", except that the board shall recover from each postsecondary educational institution which is an accredited independent institution as defined by subsection (e) of K.S.A. 72-6107 and amendments thereto all of the costs incurred for the acquisition and broadcast of such courses on behalf of such accredited independent institution or such portion of the costs attributable to the proportionate use of such courses thereby";

On page 2, in line 52, by striking "or" and inserting in lieu thereof a comma; in line 54, preceding the period by inserting "or any accredited independent institution as defined by subsection (e) of K.S.A. 72-6107 and amendments thereto";

And the substitute bill be passed as amended.
