The committee held a hearing on HB 3051, confidentiality of certain excise tax information.

The chairman called on Bill Edds, Revenue Department, to explain this legislation which would make confidential all information received by the Department of Revenue from applications for licensure and registration or returns and reports. He said the bill makes it unlawful for any official to disclose any such information and makes violations a class B misdemeanor. He doesn't believe the legislature intended that the department provide financial information to individuals seeking this information and this bill would make the law similar to the rest of the taxes they administer.

Senator Thiessen moved and Senator Allen seconded a motion to report HB 3051 favorable for passage. The motion passed.

The chairman adjourned the meeting at 11:15 a.m. The committee will meet on Monday, March 19.
