MINUTES OF THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON EDUCATION

Chairman Joseph C. Harder called the meeting to order and then asked for Committee discussion and/or action on the following bills:

SB 498 - Schools, compulsory attendance age of children. Senator McCray made a conceptual motion to amend the bill so as to make it become effective one year later, on July 1, 1985. This motion was seconded by Senator Bogina, and the amendment was adopted.

Senator McCray then moved that SB 498, as amended, be recommended favorably for passage. Senator Bogina seconded this motion. However, after Committee discussion, Senator McCray withdrew his motion, and Senator Bogina withdrew his second to recommend the bill favorably for passage. The Committee agreed to recommend the bill for study by a legislative interim committee. The Chairman said he would include the concept of SB 498 in his letter of recommendation to the Legislative Coordinating Council.

SB 473 - Schools, minimum competency assessment of basic skills of pupils  
SB 512 - School districts, achievement testing programs

Because SB 473 and SB 512 both relate to the same subject of achievement testing in schools, the Chairman suggested that both bills be discussed simultaneously. Following Committee discussion, the Chairman announced that a Committee vote on the bills will be delayed until a later time.

The Chairman adjourned the meeting.
