The Committee discussed SB 511. The Chairman appointed Senator Reilly and Senator Johnston to a subcommittee to study SB 511 and report back to the full Committee.

Motion was made by Senator Johnston and seconded by Senator Reilly to report SB 732 favorably. The motion was adopted.

Motion was made by Senator Johnston and seconded by Senator Talkington to report SB 653 adversely. The motion was adopted.

The Committee discussed SB 493.

Motion was made by Senator Reilly to strike SB 493 and to repeal K.S.A. 75-4306. Senator Gannon seconded the motion. The motion was adopted.

Substitute motion was made by Senator Talkington to amend SB 493 by striking the criminal provision. Senator Reilly seconded the motion. The motion was adopted.

Motion was made by Senator Reilly and seconded by Senator Gannon to report SB 493 as amended favorably. The motion was adopted.

The Committee discussed SB 299. Senator Reilly withdrew his motion of February 14, to amend SB 299 by eliminating the petition process.

Motion was made by Senator Reilly to report SB 299 as amended favorably. Senator Talkington seconded the motion. The motion was adopted.

Motion was made by Senator Roitz to report SB 380 adversely. Senator Talkington seconded the motion. The motion was adopted.

Motion was made by Senator Gannon and seconded by Senator Norvell to adopt the Committee minutes of February 13. The motion was adopted.
