The members of the committee discussed SB 857.

Motion was made by Senator Talkington and seconded by Senator Gannon to report SB 857 favorably. The motion was adopted.

Motion was made by Senator Hayden and seconded by Senator Talkington to report SB 852 favorably. The motion was adopted.

Motion was made by Senator Johnston and seconded by Senator Talkington to amend HB 2811 by inserting in Sec. 1, line 25, after the word "incapacited" "or moves such person's place of residence from the election district"; by inserting "Any" and deleting "such" in line 25; by inserting "for withdrawal" in line 25, after "request"; and by inserting "or the candidate" in line 26, after "representative". The motion was adopted. (Attachment 1)

Motion was made by Senator Johnston and seconded by Senator Hayden to report HB 2811 as amended favorably. The motion was adopted.

Motion was made by Senator Talkington and seconded by Senator Gannon to amend and report HB 3042 favorably, by deleting Sec. 1 and Sec. 2 from the bill. The motion was adopted.

Motion was made by Senator Norvell and seconded by Senator Talkington to adopt the committee minutes of March 12, March 13 and March 20. The motion was adopted.

HOUSE BILL 2811

Section 1. K.S.A. 25-306b is hereby amended to read as follows:

25-306b. (a) The name of any person who has been nominated by any means whatsoever for any national, state, county or township office may cause his name to shall not be withdrawn from nomination by his except if such person dies, or becomes legally incapacitated or moves such person's place of residence from the election district. Any such request for withdrawal shall be in writing, signed by such person's legal representative or the candidate and acknowledged before an officer qualified to take acknowledgments of deeds.
