Senator Gordon moved that the minutes of the April 4, 1984 meeting be approved. Vice-Chairman Kerr seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

H.B. 2740 - Hazardous and solid waste; amendments to the act

Senator Feleciano moved that the bill be amended by striking subsection (b) beginning on line 1088 and inserting the following: "(b) No penalty shall be imposed pursuant to this section except, after notice of violation and opportunity for hearing, upon the written order of the Secretary or the Director of the Division of Environment, if designated by the Secretary, to the person who committed the violation. The order shall state the violation, the penalty to be imposed and in the case of an order of the Director of the Division of Environment, the right to appeal to the Secretary for a hearing thereon. Any person may appeal to the Secretary for a hearing thereon. Any person may appeal an order of the Director of the Division of Environment by making a written request to the Secretary for a hearing within 15 days of receipt of such order. The Secretary shall hear the person within 30 days after receipt of such request unless that period is waived or extended with written consent of all parties or for good cause shown and shall give not less than 10 days written notice of the time and place of the hearing. Within 30 days after such hearing and receipt of briefs or oral arguments, the Secretary shall affirm, reverse or modify the order of the Director and shall specify the reasons therefor. Nothing in this act shall require the observance of formal rules of evidence or pleading at any hearing before the Secretary or Director.", and further that the Revisor be authorized to make necessary clean-up changes. Senator Gordon seconded the motion, and the motion carried. Senator Feleciano moved that the bill be amended by striking "3333" from line 1116 and inserting "3433" in its place. Senator Gordon seconded the motion, and the motion carried. Senator Hess moved that H.B. 2740, as amended, be recommended favorably for passage. Senator Feleciano seconded the motion, and the motion carried 10-0.

H.B. 2760 - Nuclear energy development and radiation control act; amendments

Senator Feleciano moved that H.B. 2760, as amended, be recommended favorably for passage. Senator Chaney seconded the motion, and the motion carried 9-0.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:43 a.m. by the Chairman. The next meeting of the Committee will be at 10:00 a.m. on April 24, 1984.
