Conferees appearing before the committee:

SCR1657 - Concerning farm wineries, advertisements.

The Chairman called the Committee's attention to SCR1657 and asked if the Committee wanted to take action. Senator Morris moved that SCR1657 be reported favorably. 2d by Senator Pomeroy. Motion carried.

SB585 - Concerning licensing and regulation of clubs; denial of membership based on military status prohibited.

The Committee then turned to SB585, and Senator Pomeroy moved to amend on page 2, line 50, by striking "status or" and to also change the word "status" in the title to "rank". 2d by Senator Daniels. Motion carried.

Senator Pomeroy moved that the bill be reported favorably as amended. 2d by Senator Roitz. Motion failed to pass.

SB575 - Concerning real estate brokers and salespersons.

Senator Pomeroy moved to amend SB575 by striking from lines 23, 30 and 34 "after July 1, 1982." 2d by Senator Morris. Motion carried.

Senator Pomeroy moved on page 3, lines 93 and 95 to amend the bill by striking the word "annual". 2d by Senator Morris. Motion carried.

Senator Pomeroy moved to amend the bill by striking lines 63 and 64 and on line 65 to change "f" to "e" and on line 70 to change "g" to "f" and on line 73 to change "h" to "g"; and also to do any clean-up in the title. 2d by Senator Parrish. Motion carried.

Senator Pomeroy moved that SB575 be reported favorably as amended. 2d by Senator Vidricksen. Motion failed to pass.

Senator Pomeroy moved that lines 65 through 69 be stricken, and re-letter "g" and strike 86 through 88 and also re-number there. 2d by Senator Daniels. Motion carried.

Senator Pomeroy moved that the bill be reported favorably as amended. Motion failed for lack of a second.

SB535 - Concerning sunset law and continuing the office of secretary of corrections and the department of corrections. Senator Pomeroy moved that the bill be reported favorably. 2d by Senator Parrish. Motion carried.

Senator Winter requested the introduction of legislation concerning two separate measures that if passed will bring to parity among all state employees with respect to death and disability benefits and employment-related accidental death and disability benefits by adjusting those budgets for state employees who are members of the TIAA/CREF retirement system and also for certain employees of the state department of education. Senator Winter moved the proposed legislation, 2d by Senator Pomeroy. Motion carried.
