The Chairman called the meeting to order and introduced two students from Lindsborg High School who were visiting the Committee as part of the Kansas Close-Up group.

The Revisor addressed the Committee on S.B. 561. This bill was requested by the Department of Human Resources and would amend the current law pertaining to rules and regulations filing procedures. The bill would exempt state agencies from submitting copies of documents to the Revisor's Office if the document is a technical manual of limited public interest; the cost of copies is excessive in view of limited public interest; and the document is available for inspection at the state agency.

A motion was made to report S.B. 561 favorable for passage by Senator Johnston. This was seconded by Senator Gaar. Motion carried.

Aileen Whitfill spoke in support of S.B. 479 stating that S.R.S. supports the passage of this bill to abolish the day care advisory committee and the rehabilitation and halfway house advisory.

A motion to approve the minutes of the February 2 meeting was made by Senator Roitz, seconded by Senator Gaar and carried.

The meeting was adjourned at 2:00 p.m.
